

4WD RECOVERY TECHNIQUES

There are various situations where a four wheel drive vehicle can become bogged down or disabled where it cannot extricate itself under its own power. This program has been specifically developed to assist those who may need the knowledge and skills to overcome these problems when travelling off road in the course of their normal work or for recreation. Participants are required to have successfully completed the nationally recognised training package unit SRODRV001B – Drive and Recover a 4WD Vehicle or similar as a pre-requisite. Recognition can be given for some units, where the gaps in learning requirements are covered in this course.



Specific areas of learning addressed in this program are;

- Operate in a safe & environmentally friendly manner
- Identify and control hazards associated with recovery
- Recovery techniques
- Use vehicle recovery equipment
- Co-ordinate and carry-out recovery using a snatch strap.
- Using a winch to recover in different conditions & configurations
- Correct & safe use of a jack in various terrain types
- Maintenance of all recovery equipment

Successful completion of this course will result in the receiving a Statement of Attainment for the unit SRODRV003B – Vehicle Recovery Using Advanced techniques.
