

# OPERATE 4WD VEHICLE

*The purpose of this course is to enable 4 wheel drive owners/drivers to gain knowledge and skills specific to 4 wheel drive vehicles both for on and off- road driving, the differences between a 4wd and 2wd vehicle, handling characteristics and general performance.*



Items covered in the course include;

- Vehicle & equipment checks prior, during and after a journey
- Operating on normal roads
- Operating on or across a slope
- Ascending & descending a steep slope, including stall recovery
- Operating in rugged terrain
- Identifying hazards
- Correct use of a jack

*The course is conducted over a full day and consists of a short theoretical presentation and the balance of the day is filled with practical exercises.*

*It is open to any person who holds a current applicable driver's licence.*

*Successful completion and assessment of this course will result in the applicant being awarded a Statement of Attainment in the nationally recognised Transport & Logistics training package unit*
