

DRIVE AND RECOVER A 4WD VEHICLE

This 2 day course has a very full program incorporating the skills and knowledge to plan and prepare for a journey, both long or short, an overview of defensive driving and vehicle dynamics, the use of 4wd vehicles in a variety of on road and off-road conditions and basic recovery techniques.

There is a large practical component, learning many and varied skills and culminating in a simulated journey where implementation of the various practical aspects are combined and practiced. This is a most interesting and enlightening course for those with little or no off road experience, and an excellent opportunity for those with some experience to enhance their skills and knowledge, whilst gaining recognition for their achievement.



The content covers the following items;

- ◆ *Environmental Impact*
- ◆ *Driving on and across slopes & inclines*
- ◆ *Operating in rugged terrain*
- ◆ *Driving on wet roads and crossing waterways*
- ◆ *Driving in sand*
- ◆ *Stall recovery*
- ◆ *Tyre pressures*
- ◆ *Correct jacking procedures and wheel change*
- ◆ *Recovery techniques*
